



Display Display for onPC

Note:

You need to run grandMA3 onPC for Windows, MacOS is not supported.

Installation:

Unzip the downloaded file into a folder. You are free to choose any folder.
You will get 7 exe-files, one for each display.

Use:

The idea behind this is to switch easy between all the Displays in the onPC software (MA3).

When you run one of the exe-files it will Display a Display - meaning the window with the corresponding MA3 display is brought to the front.
MA3 onPC does not need to have focus for this to work!

On a StreamDeck you can add an 'Open' button (System) for each file.
Browse to your selected folder to assign files to the buttons.

If you don't have a StreamDeck you could make Windows shortcuts to all the files and assign keyboard shortcuts to them. Any other way you run the exe-files will also do the trick.

Please note!

The display must be open already for this to work. It does not send any commands into onPC.

Technical info: The exe-files are compiled AutoHotkey scripts.
